Breakthrough supports young people in San Francisco on the path to college, and trains outstanding college students for education careers. Founded in 1993, we're a community involvement initiative of San Francisco Day School and an affiliate of Breakthrough Collaborative.

Students

- 134 fifth – eighth graders from across San Francisco including 15 from District 5, growing to 280 by 2017
- 98% low-income and of color
- Participate in intensive, year-round academic enrichment programming and leadership development
- Record 0.5 – 1.3 school years' worth of progress in math and literacy each summer

Intern Teachers

- 32 college students from top-tier schools nationwide
- 9% admissions rate
- Participate in intensive 8-week summer teaching internship, including 150 hours of training and professional development led by experienced classroom teachers
- 73% of interns pursue work in the education field
